<b>Segura Viudas Cava Brut, Catalonia, Spain</b> <i>white fruits, citrus, and tropical fruits on the nose; the palate is complex and full of flavor; long, dry finish; aged on lees; perfect with milk cheeses or brie</i>	10 / --
<b>Segura Viudas Cava Brut Rosé, Catalonia, Spain</b> <i>bright, light strawberry pink; youthful fruit aromas of strawberry, redcurrant and grenadine; refreshing on the palate, full of cherry and a light acidity; soft finish</i>	10 / --
<b>Biagio Moscato Spumante, Italy</b> <i>yellow straw in color; agreeably sweet and delicate flavor featuring apricot and peach; great chilled on its own or with desserts, especially tarts and cakes</i>	10 / --

<b>2022 Matua Wines Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand</b> <i>classic and deliciously pure; bursting with ripe lemon and a hint of passionfruit and basil; classic cut-grass and green melon flavors; so refreshing...</i>	11 / 33
<b>2020 Fleur du Cap Sauvignon Blanc, Stellenbosch, South Africa</b> <i>the nose bursts with lime, passion fruit, white peach, and slight green pepper; balanced with a zesty acidity and fruit flavors; fresh and lingering</i>	12 / 36

<b>2021 Mirizzi Montecappone Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Marche, Italy</b> <i>white peach, hawthorn, and thyme on the nose; medium-bodied with a crisp, elegant finish; excellent as an aperitif or as a perfect pairing with spaghetti cacio e pepe</i>	14 / 42
<b>2021 Badenhorst Family Wines 'Secateurs' Chenin Blanc, Paardeberg, Swartland, South Africa</b> <i>deep straw color; aromas are flinty with honey, orange blossom and white stone fruit notes; dry and honeyed; ripe flavors and fresh acidity</i>	15 / 45
<b>2021 Vallevo Trebbiano d' Abruzzo, Italy</b> <i>aromas of almond, citrus and a hint of herbs; dry and finishes with a very attractive hint of apple-skin; very flavorful so good with food, but also great by itself</i>	12 / 37
<b>Hermann Wiemer Field White, Seneca Lake, New York (Non-vintage)</b> <i>consists of Riesling, Gruner Veltliner, and Chardonnay; what a combo!; notes of honey, apricot and peach; medium body; minerality on the finish; crisp and elegant</i>	14 / 41
<b>2021 Zlatan Otok 'Bilo Idro' Marina Cuvee, Hvar, Croatia</b> <i>a blend of native Croatian grapes, this wine is fresh, crisp, and "carefree"; refreshing and delicate with citrus lemon grass; a touch of saltiness makes it shine</i>	13 / 38
<b>2020 La Vierge 'Jezebelle' Chardonnay, Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge, Walker Bay, South Africa</b> <i>aromatic lime, white floral and stone fruit; mineral character on the nose; expresses "zip" and texture on the palate; combines well with seafood and white meat dishes</i>	15 / 44
<b>2021 William Hill Estate Winery Chardonnay, North Coast, California</b> <i>a delicious chard with buttered brioche and cooked apple character; it offers buttery aromas and pastry flavors alongside a lingering vanilla finish</i>	14 / 43

<b>2021 Peyrassol 'La Croix' Rosé, Méditerranée, Provence, France</b> <i>this expressive blend has notes of red fruits with a savory undertone; a touch of greenness on the palate gives this fresh, lively wine its truly thirst-quenching character</i>	13 / 39
<b>2022 Casas del Bosque Rosé of Pinot Noir, Casablanca Valley, Chile</b> <i>delicately fruity with hints of strawberry; bone dry with ample body and refreshing acidity; notes of roses give the wine a unique identity</i>	11 / 33

<b>2021 Opstal Wines Cinsault, Breedekloof, Breede River Valley, South Africa</b> <i>a “smashable” wine made to enjoy in the summer; generous red fruit flavors; a touch of grip and tangy presence; matured in oak casks to add depth; serve slightly chilled</i>	13 / 39
<b>2020 Château de Corcelles Vieilles Vignes, Brouilly, Beaujolais, France</b> <i>the exuberance of the fruit combines with the softness of the tannins; floral with juicy black fruits; nice acidity and easy drinking; reveals the elegance of the vintage</i>	13 / 38
<b>2020 Stephen Vincent Pinot Noir, North Coast, California</b> <i>fragrant aroma of red currant backed by earthy undertones; flavors of raspberry and pomegranate with a hint of mocha; well-integrated and balanced; soft, rich, and lingering</i>	14 / 41
<b>2021 Benguela Cove ‘Lighthouse’ Syrah, Walker Bay, South Africa</b> <i>violet, plum, and blueberry aromatic notes; on the palate, a savory character with well-chiseled tannins and an assertive acidity concluding with notes of dark chocolate</i>	12 / 37
<b>2019 Meerlust Estate Red Blend, Stellenbosch, South Africa</b> <i>Bordeaux-style blend; intense fresh red fruit combines with floral, spicy notes in a medium-bodied wine with a soft, silky texture; perfect with meat and game</i>	14 / 42
<b>2020 Masciarelli Montepulciano d’Abruzzo, Italy</b> <i>rich and ripe dark cherry fruit along with attractive spicy, smoky notes; fleshy and full, with surprising depth and length; terrific with roasted meats, pastas, and pizza</i>	12 / 36
<b>2021 Masseria Li Veli ‘Orion’ Salento Primitivo, Puglia, Italy</b> <i>light jam, orange peel, and plum compote aromas and flavors; medium-bodied with light tannins and a flavorful finish; pairs with full-flavored or spicy dishes</i>	13 / 40
<b>2020 St Hubert’s ‘The Stag’ Red Blend, Paso Robles, California</b> <i>aromas of blackberry, boysenberry, and plum preserves; flavors of lively dark berries alongside allspice and graham cracker crust notes; great structure and velvety smooth</i>	14 / 43
<b>2020 Bodegas Salentein Reserve Malbec, Uco Valley, Argentina</b> <i>intense with outstanding aromas of red fruits and black berries; fruity and fresh with good intensity; complex with a lingering finish</i>	15 / 45
<b>2019 Château Sablonnets, Bordeaux, France</b> <i>medium to full bodied with a good balance between ripe plummy fruit and berry flavors; plenty of concentration and tannins that are fine-grained, smooth, and supple</i>	12 / 35
