<i>white fruits, citrus, and tropical fruits on the nose; the palate is complex and full of flavor; long, dry finish; aged on lees; perfect with milk cheeses or brie</i>

<i>wildly aromatic; an abundance of white peach and citrus blossom with a honeysuckle floral kick; strong flavor punctuated by a delicate effervescence; sweet and delicious</i>

<i>the exuberance of the fruit combines with the softness of the tannins; floral with juicy black fruits; nice acidity and easy drinking; reveals the elegance of the vintage</i>

<i>fragrant aroma of red currant backed by earthy undertones; flavors of raspberry and pomegranate with a hint of mocha; well-integrated and balanced; soft, rich, and lingering</i>

<i>deep aromas of bramble and cherry pie; notes of cherry fruit, savory herbs, and cinnamon; mushrooms and earth add to the complexity; mouthwatering acid; lengthy finish</i>

<i>red with violet flashes; on the nose, fresh red fruits, berries and stick licorice; upon tasting, flavors of red fruits and berries along with smoky tones; subtle yet inviting</i>

<i>dark red with purple reflections; sophisticated aroma of forest fruits; fine and complex; well-rounded, full-bodied, well-balanced, and persistent</i>

<i>Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, and Counoise grapes; wild red berried fruit with a rich finish complete with hints of dark red/blue fruits; Margerum’s flagship wine</i>

<i>rich and ripe dark cherry fruit along with attractive spicy, smoky notes; fleshy and full, with surprising depth and length; terrific with roasted meats, pastas, and pizza</i>

<i>light jam, orange peel, and plum compote aromas and flavors; medium-bodied with light tannins and a flavorful finish; pairs with full-flavored or spicy dishes</i>	
2021 Telmo Rodriguez ‘Al-Muvedre’ Monastrell, Alicante, Valencia, Spain	11 / 33
<i>100% Monastrell (Mourvèdre); from old bush vines on sand and gravel soil; intense, sinewy, and dark with a seam of brightness that makes it effortlessly drinkable</i>	
2020 Belasco de Baquedano ‘Llama’ Old Vine Malbec, Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza, Argentina	13 / 39
<i>modern style Malbec with fruity aromas of cherries, blackberries, and plums with “toasty” hints; well-structured with an explosion of fruit flavors and light oaky notes</i>	
2020 Baroni Campanino ‘Intenso’ Sangiovese, Umbria, Italy	16 / 48
<i>a great medium-body Sangiovese with soft tannins and bright acidity but a rather fruit-forward profile of plum and cherries as well as a surprising balsamic note</i>	
2019 Château Sablonnets, Bordeaux, France	12 / 35
<i>medium to full bodied with a good balance between ripe plummy fruit and berry flavors; plenty of concentration and tannins that are fine-grained, smooth, and supple</i>	
2021 Broadside Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, California	15 / 44
<i>big blast of cedar, cigar box, and blackberry aromas; flavors of plum, black olive, and dark chocolate; big and dusty; a delicate core of acidity stretches out the finish</i>	
2017 Angelo Cellars ‘Red Block’, Napa Valley, California	16 / 49
<i>50% Cabernet / 50% Merlot; beautiful red fruit flavors of CA come through and it has a long lasting finish to appreciate; great sipping red wine that also goes with food</i>
